

Education Grants Second Semester 2019







ARA TŪHONO TRUST EDUCATION GRANTS - SUMMER 2018-2019

The closing date for grant applications is 04 June 2019.

- Grants are available to students who affiliate to the Hōkai Nuku members, being Ngāti Whātua, Ngāti Mauku/Ngāti Kauae of Te Uri o Hau, Ngāti Rango and Ngāti Manuhiri and who are studying at a tertiary education institution in New Zealand.
- Applicants must be a registered member of one or more of the following authorities; Ngāti Manuhiri Settlement Trust; Te Rūnanga o Ngāti Whātua; Ngā Maunga Whakahii o Kaipara Development Trust and TeUri o Hau Settlement Trust.
- Grants are available for full-time and part-time study.
- The tenure of the grant is one year. Applicants must submit a new application each year.
- Grants will contribute towards tuition fees or other necessary costs that apply to study.
- Applicants who are eligible for 'fees free' or have no tuition fees associated with their course are not then able to apply to the Ara Tūhono Trust for assistance towards tuition fees.
- Confirmation of enrolment, programme of study and tuition costs and/or other costs must be supplied and verified before the grant can be assessed and deposited.
- Applicants must provide evidence of a verified bank account from the educational institute before the grant can be deposited.
- If eligible, grants in consecutive years will depend on academic record. Performance will be reviewed and applicants must pass a minimum of 75% of courses to be eligible again. In this case, applicants will be asked to supply their academic record.
- If an applicant withdraws from their course or individual papers prior to receiving funding or after receiving funding, they must notify Hōkai Nuku and the funds will be required to be returned. If this does not occur, an applicant may not be eligible for further grants.
- Upon graduation, all successful grant recipients must provide the Ara Tūhono Trust and Hōkai Nuku with a verified copy of their certificate, diploma and/or degree.
- Hōkai Nuku and the Northern Express Group (NX2) may require successful applicants to participate in some limited
 publicity or activities as a condition of the grant. Notification of any requirement will be provided to successful
 applicants. Hōkai Nuku and NX2 reserves the right to use a successful applicant's name and other details for publicity and
 promotion purposes.
- The Ara Tūhono Trust and Hōkai Nuku have the sole discretion to accept or decline any application that does not meet the grant criteria.
